# Conditions of Competition

## 1. Eligibility

Players must be a member of the school community by way of parent, old parent, old boy, current boy, staff or friend of the school community.

## 2. Format

The course is provided by Waitikiri Golf Course.

The Championship will be played over 9 holes.

If inclement weather disrupts the play then another date will be chosen.

## 3. General Rules of Play

(a) The championship will be played as a foursomes type tournament. Each team player will alternate their shot during play. Each shot will be counted.

(b) A team will consist of two players. One player must be a student currently attending Medbury School.

(c) Handicaps will be used to determine final scores.

(d) Shot gun start over all 9 holes.

(e) Start time is 9 am.

(f) Code of Conduct: All competitors are responsible for conducting themselves to the high standard expected of Medbury School.

The overall winning team will be the 2010 Medbury Community Cup winners. A cup will be presented to the winning team at end of play.

## 4. Winning Team

Winning Team will be announced using the Gross Score method. This method counts all shots taken, by the team, on the course. The runner up team will be announced using the Net Score method. This method counts the gross score less handicap.

## 5. Handicap

If a handicap is applicable, it should be given to officials as an honest reflection of your ability, regardless of whether or not a handicap is still effective by club standards.

## 6. Entry

Entry Fee will be \$45 per head.

## 7. Registration

All competitors must register by completing and returning the registration form to the school office by 3rd September, 2010 (this date may possibly be extended if openings remain). In addition, all competitors must present themselves and pay at the Waitikiri Golf Club before 8:45am on the day of play.
