Dear Parents,

In this booklet, the sporting options for your son are outlined, along with answers to questions you may have. Please discuss these with your son, complete the Reply Form at the back, and return it to the school office by Monday 28 November 2011.

Does my son have to play sport on a Saturday?

All boys in Years 3 to 8 are expected to commit to a Saturday sport throughout the summer and winter seasons.

If my son is a cricketer does he need to play cricket for Medbury on a Saturday?

Your son is expected to play cricket on a Saturday for Medbury.

Does my son have to play cricket for Medbury if he is already in another club team?

If your son is a new boy to Medbury in Term 1 2012 he may already be in a cricket team from Term 4 2011. He can continue playing for his team until the end of Term 1. However, he will not be eligible to play for Medbury at inter-school fixtures.

How can my son play Interclub Tennis if he does not wish to play cricket?

The Canterbury Tennis season began Term 4 2011 and ends at the end of Term 1 2012. Therefore, your son can join Te Kura Tennis Club at the beginning of Term 4 2012 where he will be placed in a team with other boys from Medbury. This will be considered a Saturday sport.

Are there any other options for playing tennis in Term 1 2012?

Please read the information in this booklet on Tennis coaching and trialling for the Top 8 Tennis Team.

Can my son trial for a cricket team for Medbury and the Top 8 Tennis Team for Medbury?

Boys who play cricket for the school will not be eligible to trial for the Top 8 Tennis Team.

My son already plays a sport on a Saturday other than Cricket and Tennis. Can he still continue with this sport in Term 1?

We celebrate all sports at Medbury and some boys may be involved with another sport on a Saturday. Please email me with the details of their Saturday commitments.

If my son plays rugby, football and hockey, does he need to play for Medbury on a Saturday?

Can my son trial for rugby, football and hockey?

He is expected to play for Medbury on a Saturday and he can only trial for one of these winter sports.

Can a Year 5 or Year 6 boy trial for a 1st team?

Yes, by invitation from the Director of Sport.

Are there other sports offered in 2012.

The following sports are considered to be extra options once boys have committed to their Saturday sport:

Term 1 & 4: Touch Rugby, Summer Hockey, Water polo, Polo, Fencing, and Karate.

Terms 2 & 3 Basketball, Fencing, and Karate.
